PRINCIPAL'S REPORT – TERM 1 WEEK 5

Kia Ora Koutou, Dear Parents

Firstly, I would like to welcome our new 5 year olds into Ako Tui, Year 1 and other new students to our school. We are looking forward to working with you.





There have been a number of exciting things happening at kura this week. Ako Kiwi Y2 pepeha walk, Learning Dispositions staff meeting and the Tamariki Waka Ama 2023.

We are on the lookout for keen parents to get involved in the Otonga School Support Group/PTA (OSSG). It does not mean that you have to do all the work but help create/drive the initiatives. Our first meeting will be tonight at 6pm in the staffroom.

Before and After School Supervision

Otonga School provides supervision before and after school for specified, reasonable time periods to ensure that students are safe. Students should arrive at school at a good time in the morning, as arriving late is disruptive for the student, and for the class and teacher. Arriving between 8:35 and 8:50am gives the student plenty of time to get ready for the school day and be in class ready to start at 8:55am.

Students should leave the school grounds promptly at the end of the day unless they are involved in supervised school activities.

When students do not go home after school, it is a risk to their safety as there is no supervision. It interferes with the After School Care Program.

Primary teachers and principals have voted overwhelmingly to reject the Ministry's second offer for our Primary Principals and Teachers Collective Agreement.




