Kia ora Whānau.

This notice is for all whānau of children (year 1-6 boys and girls) who are interested in playing Netball in Term 4 this year.

This tournament is 6 games and will be held on Monday afternoons at the Rotorua Netball Courts on Malfroy Road.

Game times start from 4pm.

The **Year 1-2 grade** is 4 aside and played on a modified court with portable goals.

The Year 3-4 grade is 5 aside and played on a full court with portable goals.

The **Year 5-6 grade** is 6 or 7 aside and played on a full court with portable goals.

The season starts on Monday the 16th October and finishes on Monday 27th November.

Coaches/Umpires:

All teams require a coach and umpire. If there are not enough coaches and umpires, some children will miss out. We can have two or more parents sharing the coaching/managerial duties. New Team Coaches, Coaches that have not attended and also those wanting to refresh are encouraged to attend the FF Coaching Workshops. The workshop ensures Coaches understand the philosophy of Future Ferns Netball and how the Future Fern Programme works and is delivered. Coach Workshop dates are still to be confirmed.

ALL umpires need to attend the Umpires Workshop: 6v6 Grade Umpires - complete the Understanding 6v6 Umpire Module, 7v7 Grade Umpires - complete the Learning to Umpire Module, both modules are completed online through Sport Tutor. **Umpire Workshop date: Thursday 12th Oct 5:30 - 7pm @ NRC Pavilion.**

Uniform:

All Otonga netballers will be required to wear an Otonga sports shirt. These are available for you to order at: https://www.uniformhub.co.nz/collections/otonga-school

The uniform is royal blue skirts (girls), Otonga sports shorts (boys) white socks and soft-soled sport shoes. The school provides skirts and bibs. The coaches hold the bibs whereas the skirts are numbered and registered to each player.



A Few Simple RULES:

For all to have an enjoyable season of netball, that runs smoothly, parents please note:

- Commitment to attend practices is necessary as well as a commitment to play **EVERY Monday**
- Players should arrive at the courts at the time specified by the coach.
- If a player cannot attend a game, please phone the coach ASAP.
- Long hair must be tied back and fingernails kept short and filed.
- NO JEWELLERY is to be worn.
- Players are to be supervised at all times at the courts. If because of other commitments, you are unable to do so, please make arrangements with a friend rather than your coach.

Cost: Please note that the fee for this tournament is \$30 and must be paid to confirm a position in the team.
